**ORDER DIRECTING APPOINTMENT OF CHAPTER 11 TRUSTEE**

This case came on for final hearing on July 18, 2007, on the Motion of the United States Trustee for the Appointment of a Chapter 11 Trustee (Docket No.: 8). The Court, having heard arguments of counsel, having reviewed the record and the evidence presented, finds that the appointment is in the best interest of creditors. Accordingly, it is

**ORDERED:**

1. A chapter 11 trustee shall be appointed pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 1104(a) in the instant case.
2. The United States Trustee is directed to appoint a chapter 11 trustee in this case in accordance with the provisions of 11 U.S.C. § 1104(d).
3. The debtor, Trans Continental Management, Inc., is directed to provide full and complete cooperation with the chapter 11 trustee to be appointed.
4. The chapter 11 trustee to be appointed shall have the powers and duties set forth in 11 U.S.C. § 1106(a).
5. Compensation of the chapter 11 trustee shall be allowed by separate order pursuant to

11 U.S.C. § 326. No compensation shall be paid to the chapter 11 trustee in this case from any source whatsoever without prior order of the Court.
